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

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


3 Student Request Center

You will need to refer to the <u>Center for International Services website</u> for detailed information. Immigration related information is located under the immigration status tab.


To make a request for immigration benefits, click on the "Student Request Center" above and follow all instructions. Please allow at least 3-5 business days for processing of requests submitted through this portal. After submitting a request you may check on the status of that request in your Student Request Center. You may find the following statuses:

- PENDING: You have started a request but it has not been submitted to the Center for International Services.
- SUBMITTED: Your request has been submitted for review.
- CLARIFICATION REQUESTED: You need to make corrections to your request based on advisor remarks. You will
 need to re-submit your request.
- IN REVIEW: Needs approval from your academic advisor or instructor.
- APPROVED: Your request has been processed and further instructions will be provided.
- COMPLETED: Your request has been completed and if a new I-20 has been created, it is available under the

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

Optional Practical Training (OPT) Request






