Requesting a new I-20 form

Use this Request Form to obtain a new I-20 for the following reasons:

- Replace a lost I-20 form
- Update financial information (change in source of funding, applying for a new visa, etc.)
- Change degree level from Master's to Doctorate or from Doctorate to Master's at Syracuse University (see below if you are moving from a Bachelor's to a Master's program)
- Add or change a program of study
- Change your immigration status to F-1

Do not use this form for the following reasons:

- If you are changing from a Bachelor's to a Master's program at Syracuse University, you do not need to submit the Request Form. The CIS will issue a new I-20 upon your admission to your new program of study.
- If you want to add your dependent(s) to your SEVIS record and receive I-20 forms for them, please file a Dependent Request Form.
- If you need to apply for an extension of your program end date (item 5 on your I-20), please file an I-20 Extension request.

Procedures for requesting a new I-20

- 1. Complete the I-20 Request Form
- 2. Submit the following documents to the CIS:
 - I-20 Request Form
 - Financial Worksheet
 - Photocopies of your passport identity and validity page(s), visa, I-94, and I-20 forms
 - Proof of health insurance coverage
 - Proof of financial support (see Estimated Tuition and Living Expenses pages)

A CIS advisor will contact you if there are questions regarding your request and upon issuance of your new I-20 form.

Estimated Tuition and Living Expenses
